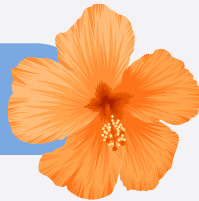

Week 2 & 6

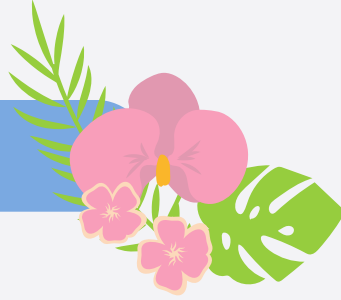
July 6-10, August 3-7

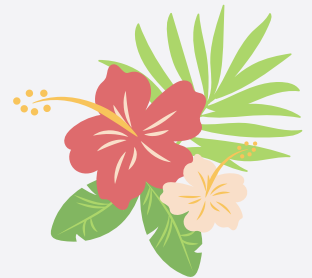

- [Admissions](#): Enrollment spots are limited. Enrollment selections will be made based on the sequence of applications received, as well as priority for existing enrolled families. After submitting this form and included payment, you'll receive an email confirming your child's enrollment in this program.
- [Class Schedule and Age Groups](#): Guidepost reserves the right to change and/or amend the class schedule and age groups as deemed necessary.
- [Incident Weather Policy](#): Weather policies vary by region. Please refer to the final terms & conditions outlined on the application form for the region you are applying to.
- [No Tuition Refunds](#): Guidepost has a strict no refund policy. Tuition and/or classes cannot be postponed in time or transferred towards another student.
- [No Make-up Classes](#): Given the limited time during the holiday periods, we are not able to offer make-up classes in any circumstance.
